1. The salary of the Sheriff of the County of Niagara, New York, shall be increased to \$63,000 per year commencing January 1, 1990, \$66,150 per year commencing January 1, 1991, \$69,458 per year commencing January 1, 1992, and \$72,931 per year commencing January 1, 1993.

2. The salary of the County Clerk shall be increased to \$45,000 per year commencing January 1, 1990, \$47,250 per year commencing January 1, 1991, \$49,613 per year commencing January 1, 1992, and \$52,094 per year commencing January 1, 1993.
